The EU Loneliness Survey

The EU Loneliness Survey was conducted in November and December 2022 and consists of two samples. This questionnaire refers to the EU4 sample and was administered online targeting the general population aged 16 and above in 4 EU Member States (France, Italy, Poland and Sweden). Data were collected for circa 1,000 respondents per country, recruited from online random probability-based panels part of Ipsos KnowledgePanel. The survey was designed by the by the Joint Research Centre (JRC) of the European Commission and conducted by Ipsos.

The questionnaire is similar to the one of the EU27 sample, but is slightly shorter as some questions or sections have not been asked. Questions marked with an asterisk have been asked in the recruitment questionnaire of the Ipsos KnowledgePanel and have not been repeated in the survey. They have been included in the document since their responses are included in the final dataset.
